8. Financial Update

- Forecast 2016-2017
 - Approved 16-17 budget was a loss of 59k
 - o Currently, we are sitting at a net of 125k before the NRS loss
 - o Includes 125k of potential bad debt of RE7
 - Met with them last week and still say they are 100% committed to payment
 - Expect surplus to grow
 - Would like to send to the membership
- Budget 2017-2018
 - Current draft of budget is breakeven
 - o Aiming for a surplus in the 10 − 20 k range
