



TEAM CANADA WOMEN'S VOLLEYBALL – 2020 NEXTGEN TEAM OPEN SELECTION CAMP May 3-7, 2020 – Richmond Olympic Oval (Richmond, BC)

Camp Objective

This year's selection camp will serve to evaluate, identify and select a group of athletes who have the potential or the demonstrated international skills to represent Canada on the International scene this summer and beyond.

Approximately 12-16 athletes will be selected and will form the NextGen Team. These athletes will be up for selection for various events throughout the summer (see full summer schedule below).

The camp is OPEN to all eligible athletes, however Volleyball Canada cannot accommodate more than 56 athletes and reserves the right to decline an application if capacity is reached.

Camp Format

The 2020 team selection camp is OPEN to all eligible athletes.

Athlete Eligibility

All athletes MUST:

- Be female
- Be a Canadian citizen with a valid Canadian passport
- Passport should be valid up until July 1, 2021

Registration deadline: Friday, April 3, 2020

- **Option 1 - Registration with hotel: \$920 (plus GST);** includes 3-night stay (May 3-6) and camp (meals on own) Hotel: Marriott Vancouver Airport Hotel (7571 Westminster Hwy – 15 min. walk from Richmond Olympic Oval) NOTE: If you are selected to participate in the second round of trials, you will have the option to extend your hotel stay (amount owing paid directly to The Marriott – special group rate). - **Option 2 - Registration without accommodation: \$410 (plus GST);** athlete must arrange their own.

Medical Questionnaire and Supporting Documents

Upon acceptance into the 2020 Selection Camp, you will be asked to complete and submit the following supporting documents:

- Medical Questionnaire & Medical Release Form
- Scan of Passport – valid up until July 1, 2021
 - o If you do not currently have a valid passport, please begin this process now as there will not be time to obtain one before travelling, or to obtain travel visas (if required).

Travel

Athletes are responsible to make their own travel arrangements to Richmond, BC. Please book any flights with sufficient time to check-in and be present for an introductory meeting scheduled for 18:00 on May 3rd at the Richmond Olympic Oval. Complimentary airport shuttle to Marriott Vancouver Airport Hotel (7571 Westminster Hwy). Athletes are also responsible for their own transportation to/from the Richmond Olympic Oval during selection camp.

Additional Details

2 training shirts will be provided. It is recommended to bring additional red and black shirts. Athletes are responsible for their own meals and there are many restaurants and grocery stores within walking distance of hotel and Richmond Oval.

Financial Implications

- Athletes will be supported financially through Sport Canada carding for a minimum of 4 months at \$1060/month (D or C1 card) or \$1765/month (SR card).
- Housing support of \$400/month may also be available for carded athletes.
- Tuition support for the 2020-2021 academic year;
 - Tuition support is available for courses at Canadian Universities or Colleges that are publicly supported. Other Canadian educational institutions may be considered for Tuition support on a case- by-case basis and must be pre-approved by the AAP Manager. AAP will cover a carded athlete's tuition fees up to a maximum of \$5,500 per carding cycle.
 - Eligible Athletes who are attending a post-secondary institution outside of Canada are not eligible for tuition support.
- All athletes selected to the NextGen team will be required to pay a \$2,500 program fee. The money that is raised from these fees will be used to offset travel, training and competition costs for the program. If an athlete is not selected for any of competitions listed below, they will receive a \$500 refund.
