- Cash on hand as at Nov 9:
  - A 100k CAD term GIC (non-redeemable) for referee development investment
  - 0 redeemable GICS currently.
  - Approx. 19k USD. 375k CAD. Some good amounts will come in from events settlements shortly.
- Forecast- Budget:
  - -130k right now from original budget, projecting -220k for organization deficit this year
    - Budgeted 30k for additional DEI/Gender Equity. Ask is due Nov 30
    - Additional storage space secured a few units down from office in Ottawa. Events staff are happy- no need to pack skids outside in the elements, or unload skids in parking lot to move through main foyer
    - International travel for indoor/ para teams continues to be high due to airline/accommodations costs
    - Finalizing forecasts for international indoor events hosted: VNL,
       NORCECA Women's Championships look to be better than budgeted.

# **Sitting Update**

- TCWSV currently at World Cup in Cairo, Egypt
  - Staged in Val de Reuil, France prior to flying to Cairo
  - CPC Security Liaison supported VC in the development of security briefs and plans prior to departure
  - Canada starts matches on Nov 13 vs BRA
  - Highest finishing non-qualified team will earn Paralympic berth
- TCMSV made the decision not to attend the World Cup and withdrew
  - They had a small roster to begin with and a couple athletes had reservations about attending the event
  - Athlete led decision, supported by VC
- Continuing to explore possibility of bidding for WPV Women's Super 6 tournament in May 2024 @ Nationals. Cash prize tournament with no WR points or qualification but key event in Paris preparations.
- OTP submission due next week. Review meeting on Nov 27

  - Distributed a revised draft of responsibilities for the members of the NRC to review and provide feedback on by Nov 15
  - Restructuring of responsibilities greater aligns sub-committees with strategic initiatives over operational implementations

  - Reassessing vendor data from first round of assessments in preparation for subsequent presentations to be used for finalization of service provider
  - o Reassessing statement of requirements to ensure it is still current and meets needs
- International Referee Development
  - o One candidate currently participating in FIVB beach volleyball course in Thailand
  - Anticipating final confirmation from NORCECA regarding a Confederation international referee candidate course in the first quarter of 2024
- Gender Equity, Diversity and Inclusion
  - Identifying sport projects focused on increasing female and equity-deserving populations in refereeing
  - Identifying sport projects focused on developing approaches to make sport environments safer and more welcoming to diverse populations
- Staffing Update
  - Preparing for the start of Gabriel Cooper as an administrative support of referee programming

# **National Competitions**

- New registration process has been communicated, large clubs very much like the change. A lot of concern about ensuring 'top teams' get in (previous system didn't provide confirmation either). Term 'lottery' is spooking some teams, we will work to explain it better.
- Pre-registration is expanded to include the PTA champion for each age/gender to support more 'top teams' getting into nationals
- Registration FAQ has been posted and shared with PTAs (attached)
- Sportlomo has been a major concern for registration they have not been following up on upgrades or concerns, could have a major impact on overall registration and event management. Would like to consider another system for 2024
- Still looking for a host location for Western Senior Open, limited options available
- First VC Combine of the season was hosted in NL and had 56 participants. Ottawa is coming up soon however has low interest so far.

  - o Montreal Elite 16 confirmed for Aug 29-Sep 1
  - Halifax applied for a Futures event Aug 21-25
  - o Edmonton still considering putting on a Beach Tour event; likely a Futures event



# VRS: (from Susan K.)

- Mid-Oct implemented new VRS Issues Resolution plan with SportLoMo/PTAs/VC
- Plan changes: meetings reduced to offer SL more time to find resolutions; Issue reporting
  now primarily done through a central online board (Jira) with focus on priority identification to
  help with issue management
- Working with SportLoMo to fix issues that occurred during nationals registration last year; challenges with getting these resolved (as these have been in discussion for months)
- VC will likely be meeting with SportLoMo this month to discuss ongoing challenges with communication, timeliness of resolutions
- Working with offline provinces (ON, QC, SK, NWT) to improve timeliness of member information exchange to VC

#### LMS:

- Re-commenced LMS RFP process
- Reconfirmed system requirements and evaluation process

### MNT:

- Currently preparing for OTP Review meetings/debriefing with practitioners and beginning to plan for next summer.
- Our athlete management system (Kinduct) was bought out by Team Works, and we are currently investigating switching over to Smartabase, which is part of the Team works suite.
   We are also looking at other providers as back-up/different options.
- Currently supporting guys in professional clubs with Strength and Conditioning, Sport Nutrition and Mental Performance or at least working with their respective club IST's for transfer of care/making sure they are hitting objectives for the season.
- Starting to touch base with University based athletes on depth chart.
- Getting ready for upcoming Volleyball Canada Combines.

#### WNT:

- exploring options for to replace Kinduct as our AMS platform
- Request for funding submitted to move from Vert to Catapult
- working to engage in collaboration with Usport and NCAA strength coaches who work with our athletes outside of the international season

## Safe Sport/Gender Equity, Diversity & Inclusion

- VC currently has 13 individuals on the Abuse-Free Sport Registry with Provisional measures applied pending the completion of their cases. That is an increase of 3 since last month.
- VC has finalized a live document that PTAs can access to view Volleyball's registry, to ensure that PTAs are reviewing the latest version.
- A counseling support session was staged with NLVA for staff, to provide support, well-being, and guidance on managing the Markus Hick case.
- VC has received a grant from COC for \$100,000 towards Safe Sport initiatives related to creating resources and assisting PTAs with compliance and enforcement of requirements.
- VC is working on an application for DEI support through Sport Canada and is using the Deloitte outcomes for the framework of initiatives.



 Review of the Safe Sport for Youth videos has started. The three NSOs are working together on the plan for launch in the new year, including graphics, communications plan, and the details on expanding to other NSOs.

#### **Communications**

- Staffing: New communications coordinator began in Oct. (Mezi Tamrat). Working with Nationals group and assisting in all other areas.
- Communication support for all teams (media releases, social media and other content where possible.) Pan Am Games (Beach) completed (on site as COC mission staff) and this month is the World Cup of sitting volleyball (begins Nov. 11)
- Continue to work with all programs to support consistency in messaging and branding.
- Continue to work with Safe Sport Director and staff to reinforce VC's safe sport messaging, especially surrounding media/public inquiries. Work with partners to roll out the comms plan for the new Youth Safe Sport tool to be launched soon.
- Ongoing: Developing content calendar for 2024 based on information currently available.
   Announcements and coverage of major National Team activities ongoing. Developing plan for Road to Paris.
- Preparing messaging and branding content for upcoming staff meeting.
