- Beach Nationals Hugh
  - Hugh was on site for the event, his observations:
    - Overall good event first time out of TO in over a decade, hosted by VBC
    - Concern over the quality of the sand ( senior court )
    - Organization by Volleyball BC was good
    - Opportunity for more engagement from the City of Vancouver
    - Overall numbers were down slightly
    - Senior Div 1 Men's and Women's finals were webcast for the first time
- Junior World Beach Championships Mark
  - Technical execution of the event was of a high standard
  - Promoter contracted Ed and Marieve to lead the technical components
  - New format lead to difficulties with the draw
  - Numerous nations could not obtain visa's in most cases the countries did not follow Canadian Immigration rules – negative pushback from FIVB
- Men's PANAM U23 Hugh
  - New event age class we did not field a team.
  - Trinity Western represented us
  - Langley Event Centre hosted the event
  - Pre-event concern of lighting and the height of the score clock proved to be "non" issues.
  - Negotiated savings on marketing rights fees and control committee numbers with NORCECA
  - Event was a test for the venue and organizational committee to host Men's NORCECA championships
- FIVB Congress Hugh and Mark
  - 33rd FIVB Congress was held in Anaheim
  - Congress focused on the election, first ever democratic election
  - Hugh believes it was the most transparent Congress he ever attended
  - Numerous items defeated that were put forward by the board ( a first )
  - Ary D Graca of Brazil was elected as President for the next 4 years
  - Hugh was elected as a Board of Administration Member for the next 4 years
