### 1. VC Updates

- a. Overall growth is approx. 25% with the largest increase in the number of boys participating. The growth of membership is creating challenges with facilities that all PTAs are managing.
- b. Coach pathways are investigating and piloting opportunities to lead the education of coaches through mentorship and a modular approach to learning.
- c. Canada Games
  - i.2025 Exemption to have all coaches (Indoor and Beach) Advanced Development Certified provided by Canada Games Council
  - ii.2029 Indoor M/W and Beach M/W applications have been approved for inclusion.

#### 2. Discussion Items:

- a. Feedback to National Championships Committee re: Elite division at Nationals
  - i.Questions for the committee:
    - 1. What is the difference between div 1?
    - 2. Would teams apply? How would teams be determined?
    - Qualifying vs not getting into event multi-faceted.

#### ii.Current Reality:

- 1. The competition is well tiered.
- 2. Elite in each PTA is very different.

#### iii.Conclusion:

- 1. Focus on better environment to perform Practice times, Courts, (i.e. appropriate flooring), 5 metre free zone.
- 2. Could change the dynamics of how clubs operate, create a different set of issues recruiting
- b. Pilot project analysis
  - i.Rules: Aligning with international, CCAA, USport recognizing that this may not apply to youth club
    - 1. 2 liberos
      - a. Encourage a PTA to test at 18U/17U/Canada Cup
      - b. Test at Canada Cup but only in top divisions.
      - c. Need to be cautioned to communicate to PTAs about not limiting development or specialization.
