Volleyball Canada would like to take this opportunity to remind you of changes to the participant fee structure for the 2020-2021 competition season, as approved by the Volleyball Canada Board of Directors on September 21, 2018. Competitive participant fee changes will take effect as of September 1, 2020.

- The following categories will have an increase of \$1.00 to now be **\$31.00**.
 - Youth Competitive Player
 - Adult Player
 - Post-Secondary Player
 - Leader – Club/Team Personnel, Referees

- The following categories will maintain a participant fee of **\$5.00**
 - Youth Development Player (Community/Elementary)
 - Leader
 - Recreational Player

- The following categories will maintain a participant fee of **\$0**
 - Leader – Volunteer
 - Elementary and High School Player

Volleyball Canada's competitive participant fee will increase by \$1.00 annually, which began in the 2019-20 competitive season, for four consecutive seasons with 2022-2023 being the last season covered by this statement, at which time the fee will be \$33.00. The groups at the \$5.00 fee will remain at this fee during this term.
