 - Adult Player
 - Post-Secondary Player
 - Leader – Club/Team Personnel, Referees

- The following categories will maintain a participant fee of **\$3.00**
 - Youth Development Player (Community/Elementary)
 - Leader
 - Recreational Player

- The following categories will maintain a participant fee of **\$0**
 - Leader – Volunteer
 - Elementary and High School Player
