Tourism Calgary has been actively engaged with The City of Calgary and the Emergency Operations Centre on this issue to understand impacts to our industry.

Over the weekend there have been many questions about whether Calgary is open to visitors given the current situation. The answer is 'yes' – Calgary is open to visitors and we look forward to welcoming everyone in a responsible and sustainable way.

The City of Calgary and its crews are hard at work on the repairs to the water system. The current estimate for completion of repairs is between three to five weeks. Our team and our hosting partners will be available at any time to provide up to date information for your events and attendees.

As you know, thousands of Calgarians make their living in the tourism industry and rely on visitors coming to our city for their livelihood. As we head into summer, this is a critical time for our industry with many local businesses depending on visitors coming to our city.
