Volleyball Nations League Volunteer Positions

1. Field of Play

- Volunteers assigned to this task will be located in the general field of play.
- They will have the responsibility for assuring the games run smoothly keeping track of game balls, cleaning the court, shagging balls during warm-up and timeouts.
- Volunteers need to be on the court 30 minutes prior to the match.

2. Court-side Support

- Volunteers will be responsible for meeting the needs of the teams before, during and immediately after matches.
- This will include keeping the water stations filled, collecting balls for the team, keeping signage clear, assisting team hosts, ensuring seating for team host, line judge, media.
- Volunteers need to be on court 30 minutes prior to the match.

3. Promotions

- Volunteers will contribute to the overall experience of the tournament handing out promotional material at entry gates and during matches, potentially working with venue staff during time-outs.
- Volunteers need to be available 90 minutes prior to game time.

4. VIP Servicing

 Volunteers will be greeting VIPs, checking them in and escorting them to the VIP lounge.

5. Media Hosting

- Volunteers will assist with check-in, providing assistance with seating and providing information as needed.
- Volunteers will need to be available an hour prior to each match.

6. Volunteer check-in/support

- Volunteers will man the volunteer check-in desk, supervise the volunteer lounge.
- Volunteers are needed 90 minutes prior to game time.

7. Transportation

- Volunteers will drive the minivans for FIVB delegates and officials between the tournament hotel and the venue.
- Volunteers must possess a valid drivers' license.
- Volunteers are needed from Monday June 27 to Sunday July 3.
