

Volleyball Nations League Volunteer Positions



Field of Play

- Volunteers assigned to this task will be located in the general field of play.
- They will have the responsibility for assuring the games run smoothly - keeping track of game balls, cleaning the court, shagging balls during warm-up and time-outs.
- Volunteers need to be on the court 30 minutes prior to the match.

Court-side Support

- Volunteers will be responsible for meeting the needs of the teams before, during and immediately after matches.
- This will include keeping the water stations filled, collecting balls for the team, keeping signage clear, assisting team hosts, ensuring seating for team host, line judge, media.
- Volunteers need to be on court 30 minutes prior to the match.

Promotions

- Volunteers will contribute to the overall experience of the tournament – handing out promotional material at entry gates and during matches, potentially working with venue staff during time-outs.
- Volunteers need to be available 90 minutes prior to game time.

VIP Servicing

- Volunteers will be greeting VIPs, checking them in and escorting them to the VIP lounge.

Media Hosting

- Volunteers will assist with check-in, providing assistance with seating and providing information as needed.
- Volunteers will need to be available an hour prior to each match.

Volunteer check-in/support

- Volunteers will man the volunteer check-in desk, supervise the volunteer lounge.
- Volunteers are needed 90 minutes prior to game time.

Transportation

- Volunteers will drive the minivans for FIVB delegates and officials between the tournament hotel and the venue.
- Volunteers must possess a valid drivers' license.
- Volunteers are needed from Monday June 6 to Sunday June 12.
