Position	Details	Other information
<b>Field of Play</b>	The volunteers assigned to this task will be located in the general field of play. They will support the operations of the match with responsibility for quick wipes, ball retrieval and handling. They will also be responsible for ball retrieval during warm-ups.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• These positions are limited to teens age 15-18</li> <li>• 10-12 volunteers are needed for each match</li> <li>• 2 alternates will also be scheduled</li> </ul>
<b>Courtside Support</b>	<p>A volunteer is assigned to each side of the court. Responsibilities include filling water stations, securing extra towels, ensuring signage is not covered, cleaning up the team area post-match, returning any clothing left to the team, etc. Generally ensuring that anything needed courtside by coaches, team hosts, officials and media is taken care of.</p> <p>A third volunteer will act as the Field of Play Supervisor and will be the point of contact between tournament officials and the field of play volunteers. They will be responsible for ensuring field of play volunteer activities run smoothly.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• These positions are limited to adults (18+)</li> <li>• 3 volunteers are needed for each match</li> </ul>
<b>Promotions</b>	The volunteers assigned to this task are responsible for handing out promotional material before the Canadian team matches.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 4 volunteers are needed for Canadian team matches only</li> </ul>
<b>Entertainment</b>	Volunteers assigned to this task will assist with all on-court and in-match activities. Tasks include finding fans in the crowd to participate, setting up games and activities on the court, helping with all things related to entertainment.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 2 or 3 volunteers are needed for each match</li> </ul>
<b>Mascot Handler</b>	A volunteer is required to be the eyes and ears of the mascot, Pepper, for safety reasons. They will follow Pepper around, manage interactions with fans, and help Pepper stay on schedule with planned activities.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1 volunteer is required for selected matches (depending on Pepper's schedule)</li> <li>• Position is limited to adults (18+)</li> </ul>
<b>Media Hosting</b>	Volunteers greet media at media entrance and provides them with assistance with their seating, media guide and any other information/support they may require.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1 volunteer is required</li> <li>• Position is limited to adults (18+)</li> </ul>
<b>VIP Support</b>	Volunteers will be responsible for controlling entry to the VIP section, greeting guests	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1-2 volunteers are needed for each match for which the VIP section is open</li> <li>• Volunteers are required to be 19 or older</li> </ul>
<b>Accreditation</b>	Volunteers will manage accreditation for volunteers, VIPs and media. This includes tracking the credentials assigned and collecting volunteer credentials at the end of their shift (VIPs and media keep theirs). They will also be responsible for monitoring the volunteer lounge during matches	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 3 volunteers are required for each shift</li> <li>• Adult volunteers are preferred</li> </ul>
