VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS U21 Continental Championships June 25-30, 2024

JOB DESCRIPTIONS

FIELD OF PLAY

*(Responsible to: FOP Manager)
10-12 volunteers per match*

The individuals assigned to this task will be located in the general field of play. They will have the responsibility of assuring the games run smoothly:

- 6 volunteers for the 3-ball system & warm up ball retrieval.
- 4 volunteers for floor wipe
- 1 volunteer to be the scoreboard operator (if required)
- All volunteers will assist with on-site and court-side services. This involves cleaning/restocking team benches with water bottles, towels, etc. between each match.

Field of play volunteers with on-court responsibilities must attend a **mandatory practical training session on the evening prior to first competition day**. Volunteers with prior experience in the field of play on an international court may be excused from attending on a case-by-case basis.

ENTERTAINMENT & PROMOTIONS

*(Responsible to: Entertainment Director)
3-4 volunteers per match*

The individuals assigned to this task will contribute to the coordination of the in-match entertainment including mini-games during time-outs, interviews with members of the crowd, handing out promotional materials, staffing the Volleyball Canada mascot (Pepper), and etc. Volunteers will also be needed to assist with handing out promotional materials ~1 hour prior to match starts.

- 2 roving volunteers to hand out programs/rosters ~1 hour before the matches, and other promotional materials (t-shirts, etc.) during the matches
- 1 volunteer to be the Volleyball Canada mascot (Pepper) during the matches
- 2-3 volunteers to assist with in-match entertainment (can be same as program/roster)

TEAM SERVICES / HOSTS

(Responsible to: Team Services Manager)

Team attachés → 1 per visiting team

3-4 additional volunteers

The individuals assigned to these tasks will be responsible for assisting the participating teams with on-site logistics and organization (ie. hotel, meals, transport to/from venue).

- 1 volunteer will be assigned as team host/attaché **for each** of the visiting teams and must be fluent in the team's official language. They will accompany the team as much as possible during their stay and be a liaison between the teams and the Organizing Committee.

VIP/TICKET SERVICING

(Responsible to: Volunteer Coordinator)

2-4 volunteers per match

The individuals assigned to this task will assist with the VIP hosting and servicing and ticket selling. These volunteers should be adults and will have responsibilities including:

- Staffing the ticketing booth and VIP check-in desk

ANTI-DOPING TEST CHAPERONES

(Responsible to: Medical Director)

2 volunteers for one day at matches. 18+ FEMALE

Two adult chaperones assigned to accompany the selected athletes during the anti-doping testing.
