

2024 Youth Beach Nationals Seeding Guidelines

The following document summarizes the methods used to seed teams participating in the Volleyball Canada Youth Beach National Championships.

For 2024 Nationals, VC will implement the point-based system for seeding for all age/gender categories.

1.0

National Seeding Process

All athletes will collect points based on results from the current competition season. The following results will be collected by Volleyball Canada:

- Seeding heading into Provincial/Territorial Championships
- Final Rankings from Provincial/Territorial Championships

For all results, athletes will collect points (see section 2.0 below) and a team will be provided with a total score based on these points ((Athlete 1 Scores + Athlete 2 Scores) / 2) = Team's Total Score. Teams will then be seeded based on their total scores in decreasing order, with the highest point total being ranked 1st.

Results associated with the Provincial/Territorial Championships will be collected by VC directly from the PTA after each Championship. Provincially submitted rankings will be made available for review to ensure each team's results are accurately reported.

Volleyball Canada reserves the right to adjust the seeding in an effort to offer the best competition experience for all participating teams.

Foreign teams will be ranked as per the results from their country's state/provincial championship, and will be assigned a point value from Column D. If the foreign team participates in a Canadian PTA Championship, they will be ranked as per the provincial seeding, using only that result.

Point Summary

Points are based on a per province and per final ranking scale. Each team's results will be weighted as per the following:

- 40% of the total is based on seeding heading into Provincial/Territorial Championships
- 60% of the total is based on final Rankings from Provincial/Territorial Championships

Each age/gender category will have its own point summary chart, see section 3.0 below for more details. Volleyball Canada will oversee the designation and calculation of all points.

The following is an explanation of how to read a point summary chart:

- Points are listed per column in descending order per final placement rank.
 - Points for BC/QC,MB/AB, SK/PEI, & NS/NB are the same for each province and combined in one column

The following is an example of seeding using the points chart above:

- Team A (ON) had both its athletes seeded 1st going into Provincials and the team finished in 2nd place.
- Team B (BC) did not participate at Provincials together. It's athletes were on teams seeded 2nd and 3rd going into Provincials. They finished in 5th and 1st place.

Based on the above rankings, Team A (ON) accumulates a higher point total and will be ranked ahead of Team B (BC) for its Beach Nationals seed.

Playing Up Teams

Athletes/teams who choose to play up one age category at Beach Nationals, and do not have a ranking from a PTA Championship for that age category, will receive point values of 75% for their declared age class results. Athletes playing up more than one age category will receive 0 points.

For example, a 14U team only competes in their 14U PTA Championships and finishes 2^{nd} . If they chose to participate in the 15U VC Beach National Championships, they would receive 75% of the 2^{nd} place points for their PTA.

5.0

Playing Down Teams

Athletes/Teams should register for Beach Nationals in the age category they intend to compete in at Provincial Championships.

Athletes/Teams who choose to compete in an age-group older for their Provincial Tour and Provincial Championships, but plan to register for their true age at Beach Nationals, will receive 0 points for their Provincial Results and thus be seeded last. Exemptions may be granted under certain circumstances such as Combined Championships. See below for the ranking process for Combined Championships.

For example, a 15U athlete competes in 16U throughout the 2024 beach season and registers for their 16U PTA Championships. If they then choose to register in their true age-group (15U) at Beach Nationals, it would be considered playing 'down' and they would receive 0 points for their provincial's result.

6.0

Rankings for Combined Championships

Athletes/teams who participate in a provincial championship with two age categories playing in the same draw are participating in a Combined Championship.



The oldest of the age groups in a combined event will receive a "true rank" in that they will be ranked where they finish, including the younger team's results.

The rankings for the younger teams will have the older team's results removed for the purpose of ranking them in relativity to other teams of the same age group.

Example: PTA X hosts a combined 17U & 18U event with a total of 20 teams with the following results:

1st - Team A (18U)

2nd - Team B (17U)

3rd - Team C (18U)

4th – Team D (17U)

5th – Team E (18U)

18U Results: Team A will be ranked 1st, Team C will be ranked 3rd, Team E will be ranked 5th for

17U Results: Team B will be ranked 1st 17U, and Team D will be ranked 2nd.
