Elementary
Volleyball eLearning

The Community Coach course is designed for Elementary School Teachers delivering physical education curriculum for grades 1-6. The course is also beneficial for community centres and clubs looking for a program that develops physical literacy through volleyball.

The Elementary Volleyball eLearning module provides teachers and community leaders with:

- 2-3 hours of interactive exercises, video demonstrations, and quizzes to support teachers on how to deliver unit plans for grades 1-6.
- 150 page Teacher Guide with sample lesson plans and assessments.
- Teacher Guide is downloadable after purchase of the e-module.
- 5 Professional Development (PD) points for NCCP certified coaches

Advanced Performance Coach

Coaches in this context are working with athletes and teams within Volleyball Canada's identified Podium Pathways.

Certification in the Performance Coach context is a pre-requisite for this program. Coach candidates may apply at any time by sending a resume and 3 references to coaching@volleyball.ca. In addition, coaches are targeted by Volleyball Canada to take part in this unique program, designed for our next generation of national team coaches.

Volleyball Canada's **Advanced Performance Coach** course is closely integrated with the Advanced Coaching Diploma (ACD) delivered by the Canadian Sport Institutes.

Note: Any coach may take the Advanced Coaching Diploma through the Canadian Sport Institutes. However, only those coaches who are endorsed by Volleyball Canada will receive the NCCP status of *Certified Advanced Performance Coach*.

High Performance Coach

The High-Performance Coach program is very similar to the Advanced Performance Coach course in the content covered. However, this one to two year program employs an "Experiential Learning" model that provides greater flexibility for working coaches.
