NCCP Certification Maintenance Guide



The NCCP Maintenance of Certification and Professional Development policy requires all NCCP Certified coaches to maintain their *Active* status through professional development and continued training opportunities over a predetermined period of time. This policy encourages the lifelong learning and continued education necessary for coaches to stay informed of the current best practices in coaching.

In collaboration with the NCCP, Volleyball Canada will provide coaches with credit (PD points) for participating in recognized professional development opportunities. Coaches with Certified status for any volleyball context in the NCCP Locker will have 5 years from time of certification to achieve the required number of PD points (outlined below) and maintain their *Active* status.

Certified Development Coach (14 to 16U age class)

Certified Advanced Development Coach (17U and 18U age class)

Certified Performance Coach and above



Note: The required number of PD points is based on the highest level of certification achieved and is not cumulative for all contexts. Example – a Certified Performance Coach, who is also Certified Development and Advanced Development, only needs to obtain the 30 PD points for the Performance Coach context.

Self-Reporting PD Activities in the Locker:

Many sport related symposiums, conferences or training courses in Canada will now offer NCCP PD points toward Certification Maintenance directly through their event registration. With these events, PD credits for attending or completing the required training will automatically be updated in the NCCP Locker upon completion of the event and require no action from the coach.

There are circumstances where coaches will be required to manually enter or *Self-Report* their PD activities in order to receive their PD points. One of these circumstances is the PD points available for *Active* coaching. In order to receive their 1 point/ year for active coaching, coaches must manually enter it in the *Self-Report* section in their NCCP Locker account (as indicated below).

Coaches may also use the *Self-Report* feature to record professional development events or activities that did not automatically update in the NCCP Locker.
