

# 2022 National Championships are coming...are you ready?

All coaches participating in Volleyball Canada's National Championships are required to meet a minimum level of training and certification to ensure that every athlete is provided with a safe, inclusive, and responsible sport experience.

## All 14U, 15U, 16U Head Coaches must be a NCCP Trained Development Coach!

- Enhanced Police Information Check and Screening
  - CAC Safe Sport Training (or recognized equivalent)
  - Making Head Way in Sport eLearning
  - Make Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation
  - Foundations of Volleyball eLearning
- ➔ **MUST HAVE to be eligible to participate**
- Volleyball Canada Development Coach Workshop
- ➔ **SHOULD HAVE to avoid a \$250 fine**

## All 17U and 18U Head Coaches must be a NCCP Trained Advanced Development Coach!

- Enhanced Police Information Check and Screening
  - CAC Safe Sport Training (or recognized equivalent)
  - Making Head Way in Sport eLearning
  - Make Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation
  - Foundations of Volleyball eLearning
- ➔ **MUST HAVE to be eligible to participate**
- NCCP Design a Basic Sport Program
  - NCCP Basic Mental Skills
  - Volleyball Canada Advanced Development Coach Workshop
- ➔ **SHOULD HAVE to avoid a \$250 fine**

## All Assistant Coaches (14U-18U) must have...

- Enhanced Police Information Check and Screening
  - CAC Safe Sport Training (or recognized equivalent)
- ... to be eligible to participate
