2024 Team Canada Men's U21 Team Information

This program will train in Gatineau, QC. between April 28 and June 8. Identification and selection of athletes will be done through an application process with video submission via the GMTM website

The purpose of the U21 National Team is to identify, select and train a group of athletes who have the potential to eventually represent Canada at the senior level, more specifically at the 2024 Norceca U21 Championship to be held in Mexico from June 9-17

Coaching Positions Opportunity:

TWO (2) assistant coaching positions are available (Head Coach: Dan Lewis). Coaches will work under the direction of the National Team Head Coaches (SR and U21) and the High Performance Director.

Coach Role and Responsibilities:

Basic coaching responsibilities to include (but not limited to):

- Assist in talent identification and selection of athletes
- Assist in developing the team training plan
- Assist in the training of the U21 team in accordance with Team Canada philosophy, policies and plans.
- Assist in match scouting and analysis

Program dates:

- February 14 to March 10 – Athletes' online application via the GMTM website
- April 28 - June 8 - Training camp – Gatineau, QC
- June 9-17 - U21 Norceca Championship – Mexico

Desired Qualifications:

- Evidence of sufficient expertise and experience essential to success at the international level.
- Previous involvement with Team Canada programs (as a player or a coach)
- NCCP Performance coach certification is desired.
- Knowledge of Canada's two official languages is an asset.
- Volleyball Canada will prioritize full-time coaches (head coach or assistant coach)

Compensation:

Coaches will receive a small honorarium - the amount will be dependent on program budgets as well as previous experience and qualifications at the national and international level. Volleyball Canada will also cover the cost of lodging in Gatineau during the training camp as well as the cost of travel to and from Gatineau.
