Re: Call for Nominations for National Indoor Committee

Volleyball Canada (VC) strives to be a world leader in volleyball, with a mission to provide leadership that enhances performance and participation in Canada.

Valuing excellence, integrity, leadership and sustainability, VC is seeking nominations of interested, qualified candidates who embody these values and wishes to serve as a member of the National Indoor Committee, to be appointed by the Chair of the National Indoor Committee, in consultation with the Director of Domestic Competitions on or before **November 25th, 2022**.

VC is an inclusive organization committed to diverse representation and to including voices that are reflective of Canadian society and of our sport community. VC welcomes and encourages nominations for people with disabilities and invites nominees to indicate (voluntarily) on their application if they associate with a representative group having diversity. Accommodations are available on request for candidates if required.

Qualifications

When selecting members of the Committee, the Chair shall identify individuals with experience in the following areas:

- a. Provincial/national championships and/or event hosting
- b. Schedule and/or seeding development
- c. Athlete, Coach and/or referee development
- d. Participant Experience
- e. Others as required

VC is seeking candidates from under-represented groups: former athletes or coaches, women, individuals who are disabled, Francophone, LBGTQ2S or a racial minority. Committee members will be appointed for a term of one year, unless otherwise decided by the Chairperson. A committee member shall serve no more than 6 consecutive terms.

Duties of the National Indoor Committee include recommending standards, procedures, and/or guidelines related to the hosting aspects of all National Championships; providing expertise towards the successful hosting of National Championships; and providing expertise in areas such as seeding, scheduling, social media, and participant experience.

Please note that both nominees and the nominators must be members in good standing of a Provincial/Territorial Association of VC. The Nominee must indicate his/her acceptance of the nomination and willingness to commit to the position.

The Chair may select from the candidates submitted or from any other person who comes to the attention of the Chair and Vice-Chair and is determined to be an appropriate addition to the National Indoor Committee.
