Requirements

- Previous volleyball coaching experience at a provincial level, with beach coaching being preferred.
- Strong understanding of beach volleyball techniques, strategies, and training methods.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, with the ability to work effectively with athletes, coaches, and support staff.
- Demonstrated commitment to athlete development and the pursuit of excellence.
- Availability to work part-time from May 18 to August 31, 2026, in Toronto, Ontario. Mainly day-time hours with some weekend events.
- Must be able to pass a vulnerable sector police check and provide proof of relevant coaching certifications.
