### Sport Development

- Planning and delivery of Community Sport for All Initiative Project 1: providing Volleyball services for indigenous communities in Quebec
- Soft Launch of LTD 3.0. Currently on the VC LTD webpage.
- Finalizing French version of Volleyball Development Matrix for release in coming weeks. The Matrix will be released without links and resources initially and updated to include links by January.
- Building a "How to Run a Smashball Program" document
- Finalizing Statement of Requirements and RFP to procure new LMS.

## Referee

- Contracts with CCAA and U Sports either finalized or near completion. Critical focus on including specific language towards conflict resolution and the UCCMS.
- Initiated creation of a referee focused Paravolley developmental program to align with the already established volleyball and beach volleyball disciplines
- Studying referee recruitment and retention in relation to the current growth of the game from a participant perspective and also in relation to pre-pandemic values
- Engaged all PTA referee groups to start logistical preparations for the 2023 national championships

## **National Competitions**

- Combine hosted in NB & NL this fall, numbers were low however feedback was very positive.
- Combine to be hosted in Ottawa (Nov) and Montreal (Dec) & 7 additional throughout 2023 working with women's NEP program on 2023 combines.
- Call for nominations out for committee members for both indoor and beach committees
- Majority of teams are confirming details for early registration for youth Nationals (of 36 eligible via 2022 Championship Tier Medalists)

#### **International Events**

2022 Event Wrap Up:

• We have completed the final reports for our 2022 events and are wrapping the final financials. Note that for the larger government grants we are required to get our financials audited; waiting to do that in conjunction with the year-end audit. Note this will delay the final disbursements from these

#### VNL 2023:

- VNL Host cities were announced by VW on Nov 11
- The Ottawa Organizing Committee has been constituted and commenced monthly meetings.
- Ticket sales to commence in February

2023 Women's Continental Championships

- No bids received in response to RFP deadline of Oct 31.
- Subsequently have recruited potential hosts; down to two candidates now
- Plan is to have the VC Convention/AGM in conjunction with this event

#### 2023 Men's Pan Am Final Six:

- Awarded to Edmonton
- Competition venue is Expo Center (Hall D)



# **VC Systems**

VRS:

- Considerable effort in ensuring Persons-in-Authority checks are getting done
- Considerable effort in ensuring PIA checks and coach certification requirements can be checked in the system

LMS:

- Compiling requirements for an LMS RFP; should be issued by mid-December
- To be used for training materials for VC coaches, referees, athletes, admin/staff

# IST

# Men's Indoor:

- Wrapped up all summer debriefs with IST members.
- Wrapped up OTP review meetings.
- Currently working with OTP to see if we can utilize the Culture Assessment Tool and Framework to help provide the incoming coach with a snapshot of the landscape. This is also linked to the new Integrated Wellness Plan we will be completing as per OTP submission. More to come in this space.
- Currently investigating a replacement for our strength and conditioning programming software as PUSH will not be available moving forward. Looking to have this in place asap so we can prepare the new system for the spring/summer.
- Continuing to support Professional and University athletes with IST support. Will be sending out our tri-annual Mental performance Assessment this week to set up our off season MPC support initiative.

# Women's Indoor

- Implemented de-centralized athlete monitoring system, while supporting the athletes remotely during their professional and school seasons.
- Developed process for onboarding new/external staff (contract therapist, etc.)
- Planning hydration strategies with Dietitian for next international season
- In the process of finding new platform to deliver S&C programs to athletes
  Teambuilder. Output
- In discussions with Kinduct on new contract, reviewing terms, conditions, and deliverables.
- Athlete intake process from 2022 is under review, looking for improvements to implement in 2023
- Beginning to plan goals and timelines with each IST member for 2023 season

# Safe Sport/Gender Equity, Diversity & Inclusion

- An update on the number of Safe Sport Cases being reviewed by Abuse-Free Sport will be provided during the December Board meeting. We are aware that several new cases have been added since the last update and all at the PTA or Club levels. Several members have had interim membership suspensions and/or other interim measures imposed as part of the Abuse-Free Sport Complaint process.
- Presentations and workshops with PTA's and staff will be staged in the December meetings related to all Safe Sport topics and the transition to Abuse-Free Sport for Complaints. The revised policies approved by the Board will also be reviewed in detail.
- A Safe Sport Complaint process review session was staged in November with HP Beach Volleyball Program staff members to review best practices and the changes with Abuse-Free Sport.
- Work has started on clarifying the process for incident reporting at VC events, ensuring that all parties (VC, Hosts, Referees etc.) are working together through a clear process. Training will also be provided with the next steps clearly outlined.
- Phase one of the plan for the Youth Safe Sport training tool is completed, and the working group is now seeking club and athlete/parent input across the three participating sports (Athletics, Swimming and Volleyball). Vantage Point Consulting is also meeting with community professionals for providing Safe Sport content. (ITP Sport.)



• The DEI framework project with Deloitte is nearing completion with a session being staged at the December meetings to review key outcomes and establish strategies/next steps.

### Communications

- Men's team coaching announcements completed.
- World ParaVolley Championship coverage completed promoted on all channels, as well as direct daily press releases. Great engagement on social media, especially due to the silver medal performance of the women's team.
- Staffing update: Currently interviewing for a new communications coordinator position. Received more than 50 applications. Interviewed five people and now in the process of deciding on the top candidate.
- Planning for VNL Ottawa marketing in initial stages. Meetings initiated.
- Continue to work with all programs to support consistency in messaging and branding. Launched "volleyball voices" in June to include stories of indigenous volleyball community members. Planning to develop future stories.
- Continue to work with partnership coordinator to integrate partner/sponsor content on key channels.
- Developing preliminary content calendar for 2023 based on information currently available.

#### **Partnerships / Merchandise**

- Our main focus remains a new indoor footwear and uniform sponsor. In negotiations with Mizuno on a long-term deal.
- Working with Mikasa to create a custom VC branded beach ball targeted towards the recreational/adult league category
- Proposals in the works for eyewear and men's beach categories.
- Discussions ongoing to target new sponsors to fill additional categories
