Draft budget currently:

- Fine tuning to occur, this was the initial submission by all groups. We will be aiming for a surplus
- Does not have OTP confirmed numbers, conservative estimates in funding (confirmed amounts Feb 15)
- Membership estimate: 4% increase, + \$1 fee increase
- Compensation adjustments: generally used 3-4% as the increase for now- will be more precise in the next few weeks, upon thorough review.
- NORCECA events- ever evolving. Currently based on hosting a u21 event in Toronto, a Pan Am Final 6 in Gatineau
- NO CSAI grants factored in for 24-25
- o FIVB empowerment grant confirmed at higher dollar figure for next year for WNT

Beach Update

- Own The Podium (OTP) Beach Funding for 2024-25 will be communicated to VC the week of February 12, 2024.
- Lia Diffin, VC Beach Programs & Events Coordinator, will move from 50% Full-time Equivalent (FTE) Beach High Performance and 50% FTE Domestic Competitions to 100% FTE Domestic Competitions on **April 1, 2024**.



- VC Beach High Performance has posted the new position of Beach High Performance Coordinator (100% FTE Beach High Performance) with the expected start date of **March 1, 2024**. Twenty-nine (29) applicants have applied for this job and 5-6 people will be interviewed February 14-15, 2024.
- VC NORCECA Closed Trials will take place **April 17-18, 2024** at the VC Beach High Performance Centre in Downsview Park (BHPC). This event will determine the teams that represent Volleyball Canada at 2024 NORCECA Beach Tour events that occur in the first half of 2024. VC NORCECA U23 Trails will take place **May 7-8, 2024** in the BHPC to determine U23 NORCECA Tour teams for 2024.

- Registration will max at approximately 1548
- New registration process (expression of interest) is an improvement over previous method
- Significant issues with SportLomo which made for issues with teams and significant extra work for staff. Requested new reg process with deadlines in 2023 so they could be tested; access was only provided on the day that registration needed to be sent out.
- Senior Open registrations are overall low; hoping to hit 8 per age per event (one BC, one ON); will be cancelling masters divisions as we have no teams at this point.
- New additions to EDM Nationals: Mizuno Athlete Zone & 18U 'farewell' party
- Combine was held in NWT this past weekend, also included WNT and IST events over the weekend in various communities.

- Organizing Committee meetings have commenced and planning is underway
- Event passes go on sale Feb 13 for an advance offer, then Feb 15 to the general public
- Started assessing options for bidding on VNL 2025-2028 events.

• (finally) confirmed that we will host the U21 Women's event in Toronto at Pan Am Sports Centre on June 23-30

2024 Men's Pan Am Cup

- Have confirmed Centre Slush Puppie in Gatineau for the Pan Am Cup Aug 18-25
- NEW Problem! NORCECA had also promised USA that they can host that event
 - Working with USA Volleyball and NORCECA to find a solution

VRS:

- Nationals registration had a few issues to start but by day two, tech issues were resolved with Sportlomo so all invites could go out
- Process was much smoother than last year with the lottery system; We will continue to tweak the process and discuss improvements for 2025
- Plans to increase internal testing and move up Sportlomo debugging/development deadlines to increase success rate of nationals registration

LMS RFP

- Vendors are providing supplementary demonstrations for specific areas (coach evals and certification tracking) to the RFP team
- RFP team has continued to meet to discuss the evaluation tool and VC priorities
- All RFP team members have access to vendor "sandboxes" to try out systems
- Process is moving along well and evals should be completed in the next month or so

IST

Men's Update:

- Currently in the process of hiring a new therapist for the Senior Team. Will, hopefully, conclude this coming week (Feb 9th).
- We will be adding a Mental Health Liaison for athletes, coaches, and staff, through one of our existing Mental Performance Consultants. This role will assist, myself, in delivering and executing our Integrated Wellness Plan submitted to OTP.
- We recently acquired "Smartabase" for our new Athlete Management System. All HP Programs are now on the same platform.



WNT:

- Finalizing order for 3 year subscription for catapult to outfit the Sr. A team
- Waiting for OTP funding to finalize IST contracts for 2024 contractors
- Accepting applications for NG therapist contractor.
- Planning travel schedules for VNL

Safe Sport/Gender Equity, Diversity & Inclusion

- VC currently has 16 individuals on the Abuse-Free Sport Registry with Provisional measures applied pending the completion of their cases. That is an increase of 3 since the last report in November.
- VC has received a grant from COC for \$100,000 towards Safe Sport initiatives related to creating resources and assisting PTAs with compliance and enforcement of requirements. Meetings have been held with each PTA to determine needs and a portion of funding will be provided to PTAs for contract staffing for PIA checks.
- The Safe Sport for Youth Videos are in final production, and we anticipate reviewing them, and the platform over the next two weeks. There have been delays from the production company due to illness and we are hoping to launch the videos in March.
- We are working on tracking DEI initiatives that are taking place across different programs to ensure that we are making progress in areas identified in the VC DEI Framework Plan.

Communications

- Planning meetings for international events (VNL and NORCECA) well underway. Marketing plan for VNL created and submitted to Volleyball World. NORCECA planning in early stages. Creating assets for events with graphic artists/video editors.
- Nationals comms planning/newsletter (Mezi).
- Continue to work with all programs to support consistency in messaging and branding. Continue to work with Safe Sport Director and staff to reinforce VC's safe sport messaging, especially surrounding media/public inquiries.
- Ongoing: Developing content calendar for 2024 based on information currently available. Announcements and coverage of major National Team activities ongoing. Developing plan for Road to Paris.

Partnerships / Merchandise

- In the final stages of confirming a SportChek activation at Nationals and potential larger partnership
- Custom Team Canada Mizuno shoe was released and sales exceeded Mizuno's expectations
- Mikasa custom VC branded recreational beach ball in the works. Release date of spring 2024
- Current focus is on selling 2024 Nationals 'Title' sponsorship and National Team 'Jersey' sponsors.
- Left on Friday attended the beach induction camp to meet with athletes and gather content
