- 4.1. Updated forecast reflects slightly above break-even for 20/21 fiscal year. See attached summary- 50k+ projected net income
- 4.2. Budget for 21/22see a draft attached with assumption/unknown notes 190k deficit. This has been reviewed by the Finance & Audit Committee



- 4.3. Membership revenues forecast: 160k. Over 200k received to date- NOTE OVA over collected, so have an allowance for refunds (brings down revenue number to approx. 180k)
- 4.4. 200k transferred to COF General fund, and 25k to Hoag Family fund, 27k to Wong Family fund Gov't:
- 4.5. CERS and CEWS: on going. Continue to qualify, and also received lockdowns subsidies. Up to 75% or Cap confirmed until June 2021 for CEWS, CERS at 65% (with additional lockdown). Additionally, claiming backdated amounts for "new" employees- a change in the policy CEWS policy end of August was pointed out and being pursued
- 4.6. Have allowed carry forward of excellence funds to 21/22, must be spent by Sept 30 2021

Beach Update

- The Toronto COVID-19 Lockdown continues. Beach National Team training continues under a High Performance Exception available only to National Teams and to professional sport teams (NHL, NBA, MLB, MLS...etc.).
- The Doha, Qatar 4-Star event (March 8-12, 2021) was the first major FIVB World Tour Event since the COVID-19 pandemic began in March 2020. Canada had 3 teams competing:
 - Melissa Humana-Paredes / Sarah Pavan (2nd Place), Heather Bansley / Brandie Wilkerson (9th Place) and Grant O'Gorman / Ben Saxton (25th Place)
- A Beach National Team Inter-squad tournament took take place at the Downsview Beach High Performance Centre from March 18-20, 2021.
 - o 1st Place Men: Sam Schachter/Sam Pedlow, 2nd Place Men:Aaron Nusbaum /Mike Plantinga
 - 1st Place Women: Alex Poletto /Devon May, 2nd Place Women: Julie Gordon/Shanice Marcelle
- There will be 3 consecutive FIVB 4-Star events run in Cancun, Mexico from April 16-May 2, 2021. Canada has 9 teams currently registered:

Sitting Update

- Women's camp March 9-14th in Edmonton was a successful return to training with COVID testing prior to travel and upon arrival at camp
- Men's sitting camp planned for March 18-21st in Edmonton, was cut short due to a positive COVID result. Two team members having to isolate in Edmonton for 14 days
- Next camp for Women April 6-11 and Men April 14-18 (needs to be confirmed due to previous camp and athletes isolating)
- Women have opportunity to compete in USA May 26-30 and Brazil June 20-27, attendance will depend on travel restrictions/quarantine rules
- Men's Germany event moving forward with planning, World Paravolley will confirm event occurring April 10th

Youth National Team Program - 2021

- U19 Men
 - Selection process underway: virtual ID process until end of April. Info session webinar scheduled for Mar 31
 - Program dates May-June 2021 Virtual and July 2021 in person at UBC
- U20 Women
 - Athletes will be encourage to apply for NextGen Identification, program plans will be based on applications received
- U18 Women
 - o Application completed for World Championships Sept 2021
 - No plans for summer programming

National Excellence Program (NEP) – Women

- 2021 Virtual ID Process
 - o 171 applications under review for selection

Long Term Development

- LTD 3.0 manual in final stages and ready for graphic design
- Athlete Development Matrix resources for life skills/psychological skills being developed
- Grassroots Working group actively meeting to support direction, promotion and resources

Coaching Development

- Advanced Performance Coach (new Level 4/5) and High Performance Coach (new Level 4/5) course in final stages. Conditional Approval process being scheduled with the Coaching Association of Canada in the coming weeks.
- Changed NCCP course term from "Elementary Volleyball Leader" to "Community Coach" in order to reflect the broader community VC wants to reach with this module.
- Development Coach workshop Learning Facilitator training completed
- Revised course fee structure proposed to PTAs

Referee

- Referee Webinar Series
 - Delivered two of four sessions of the current referee webinar series
 - Safe Sport (February 21)
 - Systemic differences between mentoring males and females (March 14)
 - Participant relationships from the perspective of the coach/athlete (April 18)
 - Technical Analysis of Video (May 23)
 - o Participation levels continue to be positive with interest from all provinces
 - Bilingual delivery of all webinars continues to be well received by the Francophone members of the refereeing community
- Environmental Scan
 - Working with Julie and Caroline to conduct an environmental scan of the referee membership pertaining to Safe Sport
 - Primary goal is to identify gaps within the referee community and develop strategies pertaining to diversity, equity and inclusion
 - Survey should be completed for mid to late April with appropriate time thereafter to dissect the data
 - o Data will also help to guide referee programming into the future
- Referee Mentorship Program



- Formulating the base framework that will shape the referee mentorship program into the future
- Primary pillars of the program are based on technical, theoretical and human skill sets
- Initiated some outreach to other NSOs to start collaborating on best practices of referee mentorship
- Annual Referee Meeting
 - Initiated planning for the annual referee meeting be conducted in a virtual setting
 - When not conducted in conjunction with the VC AGM, the meeting is typically scheduled for the following week
 - We are looking to expand the agenda from standard administrative processes to be more inclusive of professional development opportunities

National Competitions

- ISET is no longer running therefore looking into AES (US program) for interim and looking into other longer term options
- Domestic Events planning still on hold for both beach and indoor
- Request for 2021 hosts to reserve space for 2023, all interested in hosting again
- Completing a SWOT on hosting formats to identify potential changes for 2023 and beyond
- Planning a summer (July) release for 2022 nationals info (website, promo video)

International Events

- FIVB has announced that VNL for both men and women will be hosted together in Rimini, Italy
- NORCECA Sr Men's Continental Championships is still planned for Gatineau, QC on August 22-28
 - Have reserved venues (new Junior hockey arena) and hotel (Crowne Plaza)
 - Hosting grant applications have been submitted to both Sport Canada and the province of QC

VRS RFP Project

- Development and testing of the Sportlomo system continues
- Refining the implementation of business processes for Person-in-Authority and Club Affiliation requirements

IST

- Finalizing all IST staffing (New hires & returning contracts) for Indoor M/W for 2021
- Developing Volleyball Canada Combine Events for a fall 2021 launch. Will complete 1st pilot tests in April/May.
- Launching GMTM for virtual tryout process with most indoor national team programs
- Finalized all data flows & database creation for development of autogenerating post event reports and opponent scouting reports for beach
- Developing a cost effective option for PSO's to gain access to Kinduct and use VC standardized forms and reports for athlete management & monitoring.

Safe Sport/Diversity & Inclusion

- Safe Sport:
 - Several Safe Sport meetings staged with PTO Executive Directors
 - \circ $\,$ VC/PTO Working Group being established for Screening and Training implementation
 - \circ $\;$ Working with several PTOs on potential Safe Sport cases
 - Women's Sitting Volleyball Safe Sport Info Session staged
 - Screening flowchart created for VRS and reviewing requirements for integration with training and screening.



- Launching Referee Environmental Scan survey by end of March/early April
- Safe Sport elements of Club Approval Program finalized
- Interview with TSN regarding Safe Sport investigation

Diversity & Inclusion:

- o Gender Equity and Indigenous training required for all VC staff by March 31st, 2021.
- Finalized an agreement with Women in Sport for participation in the Playbook Program starting in April 2021 – working with the Ryerson Institute on Diversity, examines gender equity in our sport and develops strategies and plans to address shortfall areas.

Communications

- Announcements distributed since last update: Renewal of Richmond women's centre agreement; new women's indoor IST staff; U19 men's program details, and launch of new fundraising program (Hoag and Wong Funds).
- Update: Auction launched March 25 to April 1, 2021 at <u>www.volleyballauction.ca</u>
- Continue to focus communications/messaging on supporting a safe and positive "return to play." Including "Road to Nationals" and monitoring the international situation, ie Olympic/Paralympic qualification ... continue to adjust planning accordingly.
- Continue to work with all areas (coaching, hp, etc) to assist and develop appropriate content moving forward. Completed first round of safe sport graphics (Rule of 2), and materials to promote coach education and development.
- Exploring ways to host the virtual Hall of Fame and create high-quality video content to honour inductees.
- New alumni spotlight launched (https://volleyball.ca/en/news/alumni-spotlight-gina-schmidt), similar to coach profiles, but to highlight alumni achievements. Second installment coming soon.
- Revising comms plans for Tokyo 2020-1 for both Olympics and Paralympics. Engaging with both COC and CPC to align with their messaging surrounding the Games and how they may look different for all involved. Upcoming qualification process to promote men's sitting volleyball, beach volleyball FIVB Tour.
- Continuing adjusting opps plan due to pandemic restrictions and postponed events. Update: Content created around inter-squad tournament at beach centre in Toronto. Tentative: promote VNL Canadian broadcast plans (in negotiation).
