3. External Relations Update

NORCECA
 Mark

- Congress will be held on-line
- No official event cancellations currently listed as postponed
- Sport Canada
 Mark
 - Emergency Funding details distributed.
 - Volleyball Canada will be eligible for 25% of core, pending approval
- FIVB
 - VNL cancellation and reschedule for 2021, same weekends and city locations and venues
 - Beach Olympic qualification extended to June of 2021
- COC Mark
 - Providing staff support and training for VC for the Convention and AGM
- PTA's Mark

Providing translation support to NSO's, activation details being worked out.

- PTA's are still meeting weekly, focus has shifted to return to play and compete
- Insurance is the biggest concern at the PTA LEVE, with COVID 19 being an exclusion

4. Financial

- Draft Audited 19-20 Financials
 - Action: Please review, we will be voting to accept at our next meeting June 9th
- 20/21 Budget
 - One with no international events
 - One with a NORCECA event in the fall
 - All include running the Training Centres in the Fall Winter
 - Action: One budget scenario to presented June 9th for approval
- Current Budget Assumptions
 - Assumes the following currently, and could change
 - Excellence money (OTP): Have budgeted for revenues to not be recognized until use in 2021/22 (move forward), to match expenses. This may change, based on Sport Canada/OTP information, to allow for business continuity
 - o VNL cancelled- may receive some support from Sport Canada for incurred expenses
 - o All Indoor May Championships cancelled
 - Canada Cup cancelled
 - 20% less membership revenue than when 100% operational, Based on next Indoor season will start September 1 (with some hesitance to participate), no beach season.



- Sport Canada emergency funds (25% of total paid subtract any other gov't support).
 Estimated at 380k for VC from SC, 250k from other (CEWS)
- 12-week 75% employer subsidy, should be approx. \$250,000 (CEWS). Likely to be extended
- o Downsview rent abatement of 3 months, confirmed. Approx. \$95,000
- Indoor Teams: Assumes running fall winter FTC's with full senior team athletes, some athletes will stay play pro overseas
- Beach Teams: assumes tour events to resume in November 2020
- Para programs: assumes men's last chance qualifier in Oklahoma, and both teams attending World Cup (unsure if this will occur/when/where). May see some refunds as the men's event was cancelled mid-march, and the host is attempting to work out refunds with providers
- No fulltime staff layoffs. Also assumes hiring for Sport Safety Manager occurs once return to work spaces is Ok'd.
- Some funding from Edmonton partners still recognized (110k for sunk costs, may fluctuate based on final number)
- In person meetings canceled for: AGM, VC Staff, TD summit, NRC meetings. Still have funds set aside for Registration/events systems meeting.
- o Drop in all travel budgets, assuming resumption of work travel in later in the year
- o Assumes Beach Nationals will run
- Assumes NEP to commence on schedule for Women's program (Sept 1)
- Assumes reduced REP to run as scheduled beginning Sept 1
- o ITC transfers reduced by 50%
- Reduction in sponsor dollars.

7. Operational Reports

Men's Indoor

- Head coach contract for 2020-2021 renewed 60% reduction
- Educational video project is on-going Dan Lewis to produce 2 more by next week
- Gatineau Center MOU renewal discussions underway No major adjustments foreseen
- USA U21 Men's team to start training in Colorado on August 1st (U21 Pan Am Cup currently scheduled for Aug 31-Sept 9)

Women's Indoor

- Head coach contract for 2020-2021 renewed 60% reduction
- Educational video project is on-going Tom/Shannon working with Kerry Mac
- Richmond Center MOU renewal underway 4 working groups meeting this week
- Contact/support with NEP athletes on-going September start still maintained for now

Beach

 Tentative return to train date is June 1, 2020 at the Downsview Beach High Performance Centre since the beach at Ashbridges Bay is closed until July 1 at the earliest. This date depends on the rules set by the Ontario and City of Toronto. Players will be given a 14-day notice after permission is granted by Ontario/City of Toronto before beginning to train.



- FIVB U19 World Championship Trials (Thailand November 11-15) are tentatively scheduled for 18U Beach Nationals.
- FIVB has finalized the Qualification Process for the Tokyo Olympics All dates moved 1 year later. First Tokyo Olympic Qualification event (3, 4 or 5 Star World Tour event) is scheduled for mid-October 2020.
- NORCECA Beach Tour scheduled to begin mid-August 2020.

Sitting

- Both Men's and Women's Programs are continuing to train from a distance and have been connecting through weekly zoom calls and team chats
- Women's program has added an S & C coach Molly Henneberry she has created the first phase of our home workouts and we began them this week
- Women's program is using Kinduct for weekly workouts, ball control drills and weekly wellness Surveys
- No Timeline for Men's Qualifier or World Cup at this time both have been postponed and will likely occur early in 2021 (or Spring at latest)

Domestic Competitions

- All Nationals refunds complete as of May 15th
- Beach Nationals decision is still on hold
- Working on several reviews: Seeding, Indoor registration process, Participation trends, Senior beach hosting format

Athlete & Coach Pathways

- Canada Cup rescheduled to 2021
- Development Coach Workshop Working Group Created
- Grassroots Working Group Created
- Club Approval Process Draft in Circulation

International Events

- We received notification from the FIVB that VNL has been cancelled for 2020.
 - VNL 2021 will start somewhat earlier next year around May 7 or 9 and ending on June 27.
- The NORCECA U20/U21 Championships remain postponed at this time.
 - o We have not made any plans for dates or venue for this event in the August timeframe.

COVID Updates

- Return to Training Protocols will be developed regionally as regional public health measures differ across the country and are on individual timelines. Kerry supporting PTA's.
- Regional differences, specific facility protocols and travel quarantine requirements will guide national team return to training timelines/protocols.
- Modification to competition regulations are now being developed for both beach and indoor play in Canada once competitions are allowed.

Sport Science, Sport Medicine, Innovation

- Indoor athletes now have app based workout and monitoring via Kinduct.
- Have increased mental health support in both indoor programs via clinical councilor onboarding (men) and an increase in online session frequency (women).



- Contract IST members have shifted to part-time contracts with hourly payout to maximize support while stretching budget long term.
- One Innovation for Gold project surround knee tendon health with a nutritional intervention in our Men's National Indoor Team has been selected for next round consideration from OTP.

Referee Development

- Referee Engagement Centre
 - Established a new working committee with representation from across the PSOs to implement a localized strategy of content and delivery
 - Summary report from the working committee should be drafted and presented to the National Referee Committee at the end of May
- National Referee Committee Meeting
 - \circ Moved to an online format and will be conducted in multiple small segments over the weekend of June 26 28, 2020
 - Planning and preparation of contents and reports is well underway
 - o Projected meeting book should be finalized for June 15, 2020
- National Referee Chairperson Transition
 - Despite some personal challenges, Scott B and Scott M continue to push forward on the transition to ensure the change occurs as smoothly as possible

Communications

- Continue to support COVID-19 communication efforts: presidents report messaging, safe return to play materials (including graphics and video) and other pandemic related communication.
- Work on new initiatives such as the app and support projects such as data mining and enhancing alumni info gathering and communication.
- Revise web site with full section focused on safe sport (with info supplied by staff and in accordance with government requirements)
- Develop content for summer/fall for our channels, such as social media/web site/direct distribution.
- Support strategic plan material development.

Safe Sport

- The VC Board of Directors is required to formally adopt the Universal Code of Conduct to Prevent and Address Maltreatment in Sport (UCCMS). All VC policies (and are currently complimentary

- VC has signed a contract with Lise Maclean, a new independent third party under VC's safe sport policies.
 - o This is mandated by Sport Canada

- Pan Canadian Policies were sent to all PTAs on April 29.

Partnerships

- Working with Mizuno to provide access to content for projects they are working on
- Working with communications and programs on branding some of the new content we are putting out with sponsors.



Merchandise

- VC and Volleyball Stuff raised \$25,687 to Food Banks Canada through the Rally Together Campaign
- Co-branded lululemon merch sales will continue until end of June where lululemon will reevaluate if Volleyball Stuff can continue

Strategic Plan

- 11 Provinces and Territories completed the PTA strategic plan survey and a 22 page summary document was produced
- Staff and Board members held a very engaging and productive virtual strategic planning session
- During the session, participants reviewed the PT input, refined the vision, mission and values and updated the expected results and strategic initiatives
- The next step is for the Advisory Committee to meet to discuss the next steps for community engagement and prepare for the June meeting

Human Resource

- Currently honoring all employee commitments (FT staff). Seasonal coaching positions: being looked at case by case basis. Contractors- decrease, as most were seasonal and tied to training/competitions
- Government supports: CEWS: received first instalment (70,000), will apply for 2nd mid/late May. Will have capped out 10% subsidy on wage remittances end of month (25,000). Continue to Investigate Quebec (have not heard of any other regions at this point) reimbursement of training expenses. Canada Summer Jobs- awaiting notification, likely able to bring on three (two were hired already with this in mind)
- Coach Pathways Manager, Ian Halliday hired (rejoining VC), began May 11 2020. Sport Safety Manager hire to be delayed, as Ian will address a higher concern group (coaches) in the Safe sport area.
