2024 FISU World University Beach Volleyball Championship Selection Tournament

Objective:

Select teams for the 2024 FISU World University Beach Volleyball Championship.

Eligibility:

All competitors must satisfy the following conditions:

- a) Be a Canadian citizen with a valid Canadian passport
- b) Be at least 18 and no older than 25 years of age on the 31st of December of the year of the event.
Athletes must be born between 01/01/1999 and 31/12/2006.
- c) Be a student who is currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at a university or similar institute whose status is recognized by the appropriate national academic authority of Canada
- d) Be a former student of the institutions mentioned in c) who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the calendar year preceding the event;
- e) Trials winners must complete the *FISU Academic Eligibility Form*. The form must be signed and sealed by the School Registrar and emailed to U SPORTS.

**Registration fee:**

\$150 +HST per player

*Both team members must register, pay and list their playing partner on the registration form.

**Each athlete will be responsible for his/her accommodations, meals, and transportation while in Toronto, as well as transportation costs to and from Toronto.

***No refunds will be given after the start of the preliminary inquiry.

****Cancellations before the preliminary inquiry will incur a \$25 administration fee.

Requirements:

Canadian passport expiring no less than six months after the event completion date.

Personal coaches:

Provincial team coaches and personal coaches are welcome to attend and support teams.

Injuries:

Should an injury prevent you from attending or adversely affect you at the tournament, please notify us of your status immediately. Athletes attending the tournament are expected to be physically and mentally prepared to compete.

Additional information:

Volleyball Canada will provide a Team Leader for the event. All other expenses, including transportation, accommodations, food, and personal coaches (should a team decide to bring their own), are at the team's expense.

Participation in Volleyball Canada's 2024 FISU World University Beach Volleyball Championship Selection Tournament may qualify you for additional full-time training center opportunities.

Flights & Travel Insurance

- The anticipated travel dates would be from August 30 through September 1 for arrivals, with a departure on September 9, 2024.
- Effective April 10, 2024, Canadian passport holders must obtain a visa to enter Brazil. Your passport must be valid for at least six months before you expect to leave Brazil.
- Each participant must know all COVID-19 travel-related requirements for entry into the host country and return to Canada. All COVID-19-related expenses are the responsibility of the participant.
