Billet Family Program Brief

#### **Billet Family Search**

Volleyball Canada is looking for members of the Vancouver and Richmond communities to billet Grade 11/12 female high performance volleyball athletes while they are training full time at the Women's Volleyball National Training Centre in Richmond, BC (Sept-Dec 2022).

### **Program Goal**

To create a sustainable podium pathway for indoor women's volleyball by developing world-class athletes who contribute to the performance of our Women's National Team and helps to propel Canada beyond the current successes, to Olympic qualifications and podium performances.

#### **Program Objectives**

- Create a high-performance daily training environment for provincially and nationally identified grade 11 & 12 athletes at the home of the Women's Senior National Team in Richmond
- 2. Monitor and support the WHOLE athlete through Senior National Team Staff leadership
- 3. Enhance individual technical and tactical skill development to match and exceed those of other top volleyball nations
- 4. Identify suitable competition opportunities through local colleges and universities

#### **Program Overview**

- ✓ 4-month program: Sept  $12^{th}$  Dec  $16^{th}$  2022)
- ✓ Based at the Richmond Olympic Oval, Richmond BC
- ✓ Targeting athletes born 2005-2006 (Grade 11/12 athletes)
- ✓ 18 athletes selected
- $\checkmark$  Sessions include on court, strength and conditioning, therapy and recovery
- ✓ Competition opportunities with local Universities and Colleges

#### Athlete Accommodation

- Provide a safe and secure home environment for athletes while residing in BC
- Match 2-3 athletes with a billet family in the Vancouver/Richmond neighbourhoods
- Billet families to provide room and board (including all meals)
- Athletes are expected to be respectful and contributing members to the household, adhering to household rules, and helping prepare breakfast and lunches when required
- Volleyball Canada provides a monthly payment of \$850 per athlete (\$1700 for two athletes) and provides
  ongoing support throughout the duration of the program

#### **Athlete Education**

- Students will register for online course within their home province
- Volleyball Canada will provide daily face-to-face educational support during the program
